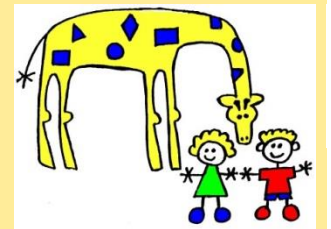

My final weeks here will include checking some things off my bucket list, eating as much Haitian food as humanly possible, and cementing relationships for future work in the country.

As I near the end of my year, I am incredibly thankful for all of the love and support that I have received that has allowed me to take part in this journey. Prayer and support were both essential in making this a reality and I am incredibly thankful for having received both.

I return home from Haiti on July 14 and start medical school at Rutgers Robert Wood Johnson on August 1st. I look forward to joining you all at Trinity on Sunday, July 20th to share more with you about my experiences.
