

This smallest and most select of the Hofstra choirs comprises the best singers at the University and focuses on the distinct art of a cappella singing.

The choir has been heard in concerts throughout the Northeast, in such remarkable locations as Carnegie Hall, the Cathedral of St. John the Divine in Manhattan, the Cathedral of the Incarnation in Garden City, NY.

ECS St. Barnabas Mission provides safe, decent shelter, healthy meals and supportive services to homeless families headed by a single mother. The program's immediate goal is to give families a safe place to stay. The long-term goal is to help mothers and children



become self-sufficient. Over one hundred families were served in 2014. Twice a year, the mission has "Move Up" day when some of the families leave the mission. And they need small household items and cleaning supplies to help them transition to their own living quarters. A list of desired items will be provided early in April.



The Seamen's Church Institute of Philadelphia and South Jersey has a mission to serve proactively without prejudice the human needs of seafarers and the maritime community of the Delaware River. This includes visiting the seamen on the ships as their cargo is unloaded and loaded and providing a safe place for the seamen to relax in when they are able to leave their ship. SCI also provides clothing to the seamen at no charge. Please donate your gently-used men's jeans, sweaters, sweat shirts, casual pants, golf shirts, jackets, etc. for the "migrant workers of the sea".

We will be collecting these items during the last two weeks of April.
