Human Trafficking - What Can We Do?

On May 3, over 60 people from Trinity and the community gathered at Trinity to learn about human trafficking in Bucks County. Representatives from Bucks Coalition Against Trafficking (BCAT), Valley Youth House, NOVA, The Well/Worthwhile Wear, A Woman's Place, and the Bucks District Attorney's office each spoke about this issue and what is being done. Coincidentally, on May 29, Muriel Rains from the Episcopal Diocese will further address the human trafficking problem at the Trinity Adult Forum.



- If you want to help, here's what you can do:
- Call or write to your local state senators and representatives and ask them to pass proposed Pennsylvania law that will help protect the victims (Safe Harbor law).
 - Go to the websites of each of these organizations to learn more. Contribute to what they do. Follow your instincts and passion.
 - Teach our kids internet safety...this is often where trafficking starts. Stay engaged with youth.
 - Donate/volunteer/shop at Worthwhile Wear, a thrift shop in Pipersville that supports The Well.
 - Donate vouchers for residents of The Well.
 - Attend the next BCAT meetings - July 13 at 5:00 p.m. at the Doylestown Mennonite Church, 590 N. Broad St., Doylestown. Speakers are from the Nationalities Service Center and will present on identifying labor trafficking victims and legal remedies for foreign national victims of trafficking.

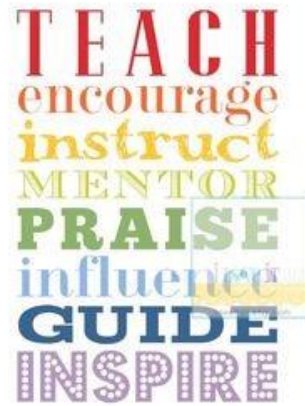

Trinity News to Have a New Look!

In order to better communicate there are some changes ahead for our monthly "Tidings" and the weekly online notices. First of all, there will be one "Tidings" for the months of July and August. That means that if there is an item to be advertised in August it needs to be in the July/August "Tidings" and the deadline is June 15.

Second, beginning in the Fall we are going to move to a seasonal "Tidings" which will be published roughly once a quarter and will contain material looking forward three to four months. This will be a paper publication that will be mailed to every home. In addition, there will be a weekly news publication that will be emailed except to those who do not have email. They will receive it by mail. This weekly communication will expand upon the present weekly notices and will have more of a "newsletter" look.

Although this change will call upon us all to pay closer attention to deadlines and make us think ahead, the end result is that it will make us pay closer attention and think ahead. As always, our hope is to improve the communication throughout the parish in order to better serve us and the greater community in mission and ministry.
